We would like your support to ensure that sunscreen is applied each morning before kindy and ensuring that children's clothing covers their shoulders to provide an additional

- level of protection. We follow our Sun Protection Policy of apply sunscreen at lunch time and requiring children to be wearing their hats while playing outside during these summer months.

Planned Self-Review Focus

In 2024 our planned self review focus was on building our teaching capability, resourcing and processes to support children with diverse needs. This has resulted in the building of knowledge within our teaching team, the introduction of additional resources and changes to our documentation of children's ongoing learning and development. We are in the process of completing the documentation requirements for this review however we will continue to review new initiatives and their outcomes for children during the coming year.

Our 2025 planned self review will focus on strengthening our foundations skills in literacy and numeracy, drawing on the Ministry of Education's online curriculum resource, Kōwhiti Whakapae, released throughout 2024. The intent of this resource is to provide support for teachers and whanau to lay the groundwork for children's foundational skills in social and emotional competence, literacy and numeracy, support successful transitions into school and identify children who need extra support early on. The content directly supports the areas of actions ERO has identified and connects with other work the MOE are doing to raise literacy and numeracy achievement in the early years.
